Frequently Asked Questions

Event Related

The Multicultural event is for K-6 students and their family. We welcome all school staff members, students from 7-12 grade with their family to attend this community building event. **Admission is FREE for this event.** In early September, an interest form to attend will be sent out to help with planning the event.

- Q: Do I need to submit a separate interest form to attend for each of my children?
- A: No, please only fill out 1 form per family - include the number of **all** people attending the event from your family (grandparents, friends, etc). This will help us plan the event better.
- Q: Can my child attend on their own to watch the performances?
- A: No, all children must be directly accompanied by an adult for the entire time they are at the event.
- Q: Will there be food/drinks at the event?
- A: Yes, there will be a limited number of drinks, pizza, and commercially prepared cultural food (appetizers /desserts) available for sale. **We will accept CASH AND CARD.**

Performance Related

All performances (e.g. singing, dancing, instrumental) must have a **cultural element**. Though it is a K-6 event, we welcome siblings and family members to perform with them.

- Q: If I miss the deadline to submit the form to perform, can I still perform at this event?
- A: Please contact us at culturalevent@stmaurice.mb.ca. If we still have room available in the schedule, we will try to accommodate.
- Q: How long should my child's performance be?
- A: We encourage solo performances of up to 2 mins and group performances of up to 3 mins long.
- Q: Will there be a stage to perform?
- A: No, all performances will be held on the gym floor with a designated area of 15x30 feet.
- Q: What type of equipment will be available to assist with my performance?
- A: We have a sound system for you to use along with 2 wireless microphones, and stands. If bringing your own equipment, please ensure it can be set up and taken down within 30 seconds.
- Q: Can my child participate in the fashion show?
- A: YES! Fashion Show is a great opportunity for your child to showcase their cultural attire.
